



### Reminders for Visitors of Camp Christopher

1. All guests, including adults, must sign a Consent, Permission and Release for Participation and submit this prior to or upon arrival at Camp Christopher. All guests riding horses during their visit must complete the Horse Back Riding Skill Disclosure Form prior to riding.
2. Groups **must maintain supervision for minors at the following ratios at all times**

Age of Minors	Number of Adults Required	Number of Minors/Adults (Overnight Supervision)	Number of Minors/Adults (Daytime Supervision)
Under 4	1	1	1
4-5	1	5	6
6-8	1	6	8
9-14	1	8	10
15-18	1	10	12

3. All persons are prohibited from the following special activity areas at all times except where prior express written permission has been secured and where Camp Christopher has provided trained staff to facilitate the use of these activities:
 

A. Stables/horse back riding	E. Storage facilities
B. Low and high ropes course	F. Kitchen
C. Archery range	G. Lakes
D. Off-Trail Hiking	H. Maintenance and Septic Areas
4. Within the meeting spaces and halls of Camp Christopher, please do not:
 

A. Remove furnishings from buildings/meeting space	E. Touch smoke or carbon monoxide detectors
B. Remove/use fire extinguishers unless there is a fire	F. Touch electrical panels
C. Leave trash, decorations or any other trace of your visit	G. Forget to extinguish fires in hall completely
D. Move furnishings within the building unless you restore them to their original location	
5. Within the cabins of Camp Christopher, please do not:
 

A. Forget to turn down thermostats or furnaces (to 55°)	E. Touch smoke or carbon monoxide detectors
B. Remove/use fire extinguishers unless there is a fire	F. Touch electrical panels
C. Move/re-arrange bunks/beds or furniture	G. Remove furnishings or fixtures from cabins
D. Move nearby picnic tables	H. Move fire rings
6. Groups may have **no more than two vehicles within the camp grounds at any time**. Please park all other vehicles in the parking lot at the front entrance of the camp. Vehicles may not be driven faster than 5 miles/hour within the camp grounds, and may never be driven on grassy areas or off road. No commercial vehicles are permitted without prior express written permission from Camp staff. Absolutely no all terrain vehicles, snowmobiles, off road motor bikes or other recreational vehicles including campers are permitted on the vehicles. No one is permitted to ride on the outside of any vehicle on the grounds of the camp. Drivers must be 18 years of age to drive within the grounds of the camp. No guest may block of any entrance or exit to any road or vehicle on the grounds.

## Reminders for Visitors of Camp Christopher (continued)

7. Groups may only use existing fire rings for camp fires. An adult must be present at all times that a fire is burning. Groups must have a sufficient supply of water at the camp fire to extinguish all flames. All fires must be completely extinguished before leaving the site.
  
8. The following are prohibited while staying on the grounds of Camp Christopher:
  - A. Noxious, dangerous or offensive behavior.
  - B. Pets or animals of any kind.
  - C. Smoking in any building.
  - D. Hunting of animals or removal of vegetation.
  - E. Abuse of prescription drugs or use of illegal drugs
  - F. Noise during quiet hours (11:00 pm to 7:00 am)
  - G. Possession, distribution or consumption of alcohol
  - I. Entering the camp office without permission
  - J. Possession and /or use of firearms, ammunition, flammable liquids, explosives, gas or air powered guns, crossbows or other projectiles, fireworks, pyrotechnic display devices, etc.
  
9. All persons staying at Camp Christopher must dispose of all trash, garbage and other solid waste and restore the facility to its proper order before checking out. All persons in your group must leave by the time stated in the License Agreement.
  
10. **IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY:**
  - A. CALL 911.** The landline telephone is located at the desk in the back storage room of the kitchen. The address for Camp Christopher is 1930 North Hametown Road, Bath Township.
  - B. If an emergency squad is called, secure all minors in a safe, supervised area away from the road and away from the emergency location. Station adults at the camp entrance and along the road of the camp in order to direct first responders to the location of the emergency.
  - C. Give the emergency responders a copy of the injured party's emergency contact information and health information.

In the event that police, fire, ambulance or other emergency responders enter the facility during the term of your stay, notify Camp Christopher personnel of the known facts pertaining to the emergency as soon as possible. You may be asked to cooperate in completing documentation pertaining to the incident. The phone number for the office is 330-762-2961. In the event the office is closed, an emergency contact number will be provided by the answering service at the main office which you can call.
