Where did the summer go?

Important Information from the Nurses:

In Ohio, a Do Not Resuscitate (DNR) order is a legal document, issued by a physician, that instructs medical personnel not to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) if a person's heart or breathing stops. Ohio law recognizes two types of DNR orders: DNR Comfort Care (DNRCC) and DNR Comfort Care-Arrest (DNRCC-Arrest). The DNR order is a crucial part of end-of-life planning and ensures that a person's wishes regarding resuscitation are honored.

If your participant has a DNR we must have a copy on file here at the Adult Day Program for it to be valid. If we do not have a copy on file and there is an emergency situation unfortunately, your wishes will not be granted.
